\$60/child; \$95/2 children; \$110/family max (3 or more children)

Registration fees for youth in grades 6,7,8:

\$75/youth for the week (price includes the *Catholic Connections Handbook for Middle School Youth* recommended by diocese; *Catholic Youth Bible*)

This one-week intensive program, WITH THE ADDITION OF YOUR FAMILY'S ATTENDANCE AT OUR FOUR FAMILY GATHERINGS THIS YEAR-10/16/17; 12/18/17; 2/26/18; AND 4/30/18, will provide your child with the 30 hours of catechesis required by the Diocese of Rochester.

Theme: Grades PreK (age 4) through Grade 8: "Koinonia: We are the Body of Christ"

-The Church (Church models, structures and characteristics)

-The Liturgy

-Faith and Identity (What it means to be a person of faith); -Sacred Scripture and Tradition; learning what makes Catholics similar yet different from other Christian faiths (the Sacraments, the Mass); ecumenism

-Personal Growth (Personal, physical, and spiritual growth)

-Ways we grow in all areas; learn from our parents, the Saints, etc., by following the Ten Commandments; learning and practicing the cardinal virtues as well as Theological virtues of faith, hope and charity (love), learn about the Beatitudes.

-Relationships (How we relate to and become part of a community of faith).

-Ways we grow spiritually: Works of Mercy eg. reaching out to the poor, vulnerable, marginalized (V Encuentro);
