DISCUSSION/updates

Divine Mercy image—permanent installation of the image, as proposed by Adult Faith Formation Committee, would set a precedent; members noted that the image may be displayed for special programs, similar to placement of nativity scene during Christmas season/Mary statue for rosary. Reflection/renewal for liturgical ministries—as proposed at previous meeting: need to focus on specific needs/goals; all ministries to be considered: Eucharistic, word, hospitality, sacristan, etc. Fr. Bob noted that reflection session needs to be followed by practicum at another time. Fall scheduling will allow for proper planning. Fr. Kennedy mentioned as a resource.

Triduum—*Morning Prayer* will be held each day at 9 AM at SJE. *Mass of the Lord's Supper*, 7 PM on Holy Thursday at SJE: Rob is preparing presenters of oils. *Compline*, 10:30 PM Thursday at StJ. *Good Friday*: StJ open at noon; *Stations of Cross*, 1 PM; *Solemn Liturgy*, 2 PM; *Seven Last Words*, 7 PM. *Easter Vigil* at 8 PM: 3 candidates to be confirmed; no Litany of Saints. *Easter Sunday*, schedule will be as in previous years: 11:30 AM added at StJ; no 5 PM at StA.
