## 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the 200 Club 2020

**Join in on the fun for the 40<sup>th</sup> year of the 200 Club!** The Club, which began in 1981, has historically given us an opportunity to earn a little extra money for parish expenses and bring together as many parishioners and friends as possible once a year to enjoy themselves at a low cost.

**The new Club will begin on March 23, 2020; no dues will be accepted before that date. The dinner will be held on September 18, 2020. In order to make this activity a success, a minimum of 200 members will be needed.**

***New this year:*** *In order to cover the rising costs of the dinner and reduce the amount subsidized by the Parish, dues have been increased. Dues had remained the same since the Club's inception, however, the cost of dinner has increased beyond the ticket price. Less members and rising costs has made it so the Club has not been able to generate money for the parish as it did in years past. With the new price of \$50, however, members will still enjoy the same dinner at the Burgundy Basin **AND** will be given extra chances to win weekly. Total amount of prizes awarded each week has increased as well! The more that join, the more opportunity to again earn some extra money for the Parish!*

The Club rules are as follows:

*Dues of \$50 may be paid weekly, monthly or in total **by check or cash.** Payment must be made by two separate payments of **\$25** each – one marked **raffle** and the other marked **dinner.** For now, during the current parish closing, please mail your checks to the office or drop off in the outside door slot clearly marked 200 Club with your name.*

Raffle tickets will be kept at the office. We can provide you with your assigned number, if you would like, via email. The tickets will be available for pick-up once masses resume and the Parish office reopens. Winners will be announced each week in the church bulletin. A separate dinner ticket will be issued prior to the dinner in September.

A drawing will be held weekly for 25 weeks with an added prize each week from that of prior years as follows: **\$25, \$20, \$20, \$10, \$10.** Only those who are current in their dues will be eligible for prizes. Drawing for winners will not take place until the minimum number of members has been reached. All drawings have to be completed at the actual site so the final prize winners will be drawn at the parish office prior to the night of the dinner and announced at the dinner.

First prize	\$500.00	Third prize	4 prizes of \$50.00
Second prize	2 prizes of \$100.00	Fourth prize	4 prizes of \$25.00

A dinner for members and guests is scheduled on Friday, September 18, 2020. Tickets may also be purchased at cost for non-member guests for \$27. During the dinner there will be a cash bar.

The club is open to all parishioners, relatives and friends. **Tickets are not transferable to another person, other than a spouse.**
