In class or at home, go to page 11 in the Catechism handbook to learn about how God asks us to love.



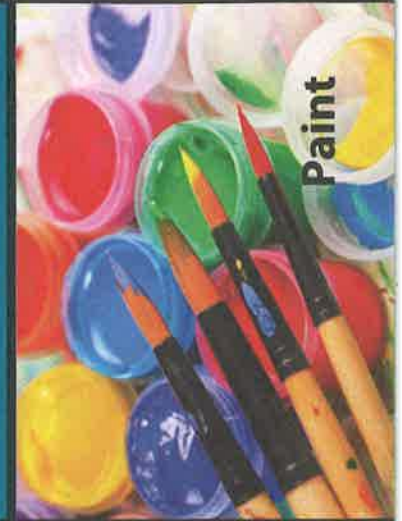
